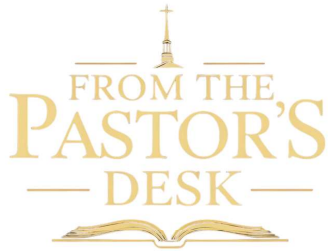

Please read the Sunday Scriptures during the week to prepare your heart for Mass.

Many of us often wonder about the origins of the diaconate and the role of deacons in the life of the Church. In next Sunday's First Reading, from Acts of the Apostles (Acts 6:1-7), we will hear the account of the choosing of the first deacons—a moment that reveals how the early Church responded to the needs of its growing community.

I warmly encourage you to read this passage in advance. Alongside it, the Gospel (John 14:1-12) invites us to listen to Jesus' comforting words: "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Have faith in God; have faith also in me." In this passage, the Lord reminds us that he is the way, the truth, and the life, leading us to the Father.

Taking a few moments during the week to prayerfully read these Scriptures will help you enter more deeply into the Word of God and better follow the message shared at Mass. It is a simple but powerful way to prepare your heart for our Sunday celebration.

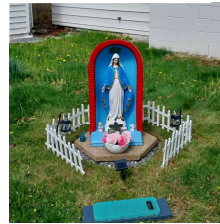
