## Readings for June 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>

**Dt** 8:2-3, 14b-16a

**Ps** 147:12-15, 19-20

**1 Cor** 10:16-17

**Jn** 6:51-58

### Readings for The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

**Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a:** In this passage, Moses reminds the Israelites how God led them through the desert for forty years, testing and forming them in humility and trust. God fed them with manna to teach that human beings do not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the Lord. He also warns them not to forget God, who protected and sustained them in their hardships.

**1 Corinthians 10:16-17:** In this section, Saint Paul teaches that the Eucharistic cup and bread are a sharing in the Blood and Body of Christ. Though many believers become one body because they all partake of the one bread, united in Christ through the Eucharist.

**John 6:51-58:** In this gospel text, Jesus declares that He is the living bread that came down from heaven and that whoever eats His flesh and drinks His blood will have eternal life. Through the Eucharist, believers remain united with Christ and receive the promise of resurrection and everlasting life.

Taking a few moments during the week to prayerfully read these Scriptures will help you enter more deeply into the Word of God and better follow the message shared at Mass. It is a simple but powerful way to prepare your heart for our Sunday Celebration.
